The HSE has recently been supporting the police response to reports of pupils of a school in Manchester feeling unwell following a scuba diving lesson.

Following an initial assessment of the breathing gas used during the lesson, the HSE recommends that anyone who has recently had a diving cylinder filled by **Aqualogistics** in Stockport is not to use the cylinder or breathe the gas.
