Biggest Fines of 2018



- 1. Bupa hit with £3m fine over care home Legionnaires' death
- 2. Tighter driver safety rules at Stagecoach after double fatality and £2.3m fine
- 3. Southern Health fined £2m over deaths of two patients
- 4. Blindingly obvious' errors lead to DHL's £2m fine for worker crush death
- 5. Two contractors in administration fined £2m after pipe stacking fatality
- 6. Car parts supplier in Legionnaires and explosion prosecution faces £1.6m fine
- 7. Tesco fined £1.6m after lorry crushed pedestrian against loading bay
- 8. Traffic marshal's serious injuries lead to £1.6m fine for Royal Mail
- 9. £1.5m fine for Tuffnells after worker crushed by runaway trailer
- 10. Tata fined £1.4m after 'warning sign' of fatal crush accident ignored
