

Typical Traffic Sign with Lantern Mounted on a Stub Post





Notes

- 1. A 6mm tapped hole is to be made in the sign pole.
- 2. A coating of grease is to be applied to all mechanical connections.
- All burrs are to be removed from the ends of the conduit before installation into poles
- 4. Wide base pole should be furthest from carriageway edge.
