On Monday the 5th December 2022 our version of Mosaic will be upgraded to Mosaic 22.1.0.2. This will allow us to take the latest bug fixes, system enhancements and overall infrastructure upgrade, as we will also be migrating the Mosaic platform to new servers, to ensure we maintain security using the latest technology available.

The changes for recording Gender were made in collaboration with trans and non-binary people who informed and shaped the decisions and development of this new feature.

Legally this is also required to abide by the Human Rights Act right to dignity, the GDPR principle of accuracy of data and the Public Sector duty of equality.

Following the introduction of the new Gender recording functionality on a person's record, you will be able to accurately record gender as well as keeping the recording of Sex (as per Health system) separate as this is still required for record matching and reporting.

You will also be able to record pronouns so you can respond to and refer to people respectfully and appropriately as well as supporting accuracy in case recording. The notes field will also recognise nuances when certain genders or pronouns should be used.

When you log into Mosaic after the 5th December you will automatically be taken to your 'Homepage' in the narrow workview setting rather than the full workview. This will allow you to keep on top of any alerts and unfinished case notes that you may have as you will now see them when initially logging in to Mosaic.


Gender

When creating a record, you add the 'Sex (as per Health System)' this will then automatically pre-populate the 'Gender' on the person Summary screen.

ACTION REQUIRED Users should review all their cases and update the Gender and Sex (as per Health system) fields following upgrade where appropriate.

Indeterminate has now been replaced by Intersex as 'appropriate terminology'




ACTION REQUIRED NOW Users should review all their cases and update any that have Indeterminate recorded in the Gender field prior to the upgrade to that of the Sex (as per the Health system) of the person.

Please note that Intersex relates to or denoting a person or animal that has both male and female sex organs or other sexual characteristics and should be only used in that instance.

New feature

The **Gender/Pronoun** notes is a free text field which can be edited in the **Person details – Basic details** menu.




When this field is completed, it will trigger an information icon (blue triangle

with the letter i inside (a) to show against the **Gender** field and, where completed, the **Pronouns** field in the person summary and the group summary. This informs users that there are relevant notes recorded by clicking

on the icon you can view the notes in a pop-up window.

will only appear if the **Gender and Pronouns** text box is completed



It is important that you are aware of the icon as it shows that there are **Gender/Pronoun notes** recorded and you should read these notes prior to using or referring to someone's gender or pronouns.

How will this change affect Genograms?

Genograms will continue to use **Sex (as per Health system)** to determine the shapes used for people within the genogram.

What about Titles?

Entering a title when creating a person will not have any impact on the **Sex (as per Health system)** or **Gender** fields.

Other new features

<u>Incorrect Group created</u> – if you create a group and use an incorrect group type (for example use a Family Group type when it is a Carers group record), there is no need to create another group. Instead raise a Request change to





There are a number of Tool bar icon changes for example


The column for Gender (now Sex (as per Health system)) has been removed from the Group Restrictions tab table and replaced by Pronouns. When viewing the group record, users' needs to be aware when any group member that has data entered in the Gender/pronoun notes field this will be displayed

by the blue warning triangle , by clicking on this triangle a pop up will display, the text contained in the notes field.


