Behaviour Risk Screening Tool	All Staff	<i>Individual risk screening tools help to identify potential triggers by assessing extenuating factors. By understanding individual risk factors, interventions can be tailored to address specific needs and promote safer outcomes.</i> Behavioural_Environment_Audit.docx
Individual Pupil Risk Assessment	All Staff	<i>Individual pupil risk assessments for behaviour help to ensure the safety and well-being of students and staff, especially when a student's behaviour poses a risk to themselves or others. These assessments help identify potential hazards, evaluate the level of risk, and implement appropriate control measures to mitigate those risks.</i> Individual_Pupil_Risk_Assessment_Sept_25.doc
