Dynamic Support Register

Being on the Dynamic Support Register (DSR) can open doors to other services, including access to LPFT'S Keyworker service for under 25s [CYP Keyworker Service :: Lincolnshire Young Minds](#) and the Enhanced Support and Liaison Service [The Enhanced Support and Liaison Service \(ESLS\) six months on :: Lincolnshire Partnership NHS Trust](#)

The Dynamic Support Register (DSR), which is a county wide register of anyone with a **confirmed** diagnosis of Autism and/or Learning Disability where there is a risk of hospitalisation or placement breakdown due to mental health.
