## **Guttering Collapse and falling icicles**



## COMPACTED SNOW IS THREE TIMES HEAVIER THAN FRESHLY FALLEN SNOW

Due to the heavy snow fall and freezing temperatures over the last week some guttering may have torn away from the building or been weakened by a thick build up of compacted snow/ice increasing the risk of them failing and falling. There is also the risk of large icicles or heavy ice/snow falling from the roof/guttering.

It is therefore essential that you assess the guttering on your building to confirm its structural safety and any overhanging and/or thick snow/ice on roofs above footpaths/doors.

All assessments, findings and actions relating to this MUST be recorded

The controlled removal of dangerous overhanging snow/ice may be part of a planned maintenance programme with due consideration given to a safe method of work.
